1. ATO NFP annual reporting. We have requested paperwork that will indicate what the requirements are and what we will need to do to fulfil our obligations under the new ruling from the ATO. We are unsure at this stage whether any costs will be incurred.
2. Our current annual set costs for running the Club are approx. \$6,335. In case of a downturn in the economy, e.g. Recession, we have sufficient funds to keep operating for approx. 3 – 4 years.
3. An application has been made to West Tamar Council for a Grant of \$5,000. This was submitted on 5<sup>th</sup> August, 2024
4. A raffle was recently held to offset the cost of Hover archery which has been purchased. This raffle raised \$742.00. Thanks must go to the small band of ladies who organized the prizes and sold the tickets. Thank you also to all those who contributed.
5. Hover archery has been purchased and is stored in the Armory.
6. Christmas raffle. The Committee have approved another raffle to be held towards Christmas. It is hoped to raise money to further offset the cost of the Hover archery.
7. Christmas party. In an endeavor to encourage more members to attend this event, a lucky door prize is being offered. This will be a single membership renewal. The member must be personally present to claim the prize at the time of the draw, otherwise it will be redrawn until a winner is declared.

**GENERAL BUSINESS:**

1. Discussion took place regarding the distances to be shot indoors by Come and Try members. It was suggested that it may be possible to bring in two portable targets to be set 10 metres from the shooting line which would enable more experienced shooters to shoot 18 metres. An e-mail will be sent to Come and Try teams with this suggestion. However, the operation of Come and Try will remain at the discretion of D.O.S.
