Agenda:

2. (a) The fault on the alarm system has been fixed.

on this ground. Members will only be covered by our insurance at club organized events.

4. Water supply piping replacement. Enquiries will be made with a view to replacing the water pipes within our grounds. Present pipes are agricultural water pipes, and they are prone to damage and breakages.

5. Mini clout, club gear access. Committee decided that no gear could be removed from the armory and stored elsewhere within the indoors or clubhouse. This decision was based on the issue of safety and the Club's level of liability.

1. It was agreed that a Lucky Door Prize would be offered to those attending the Christmas Party. This would consist of a free renewal of membership.


