-Family Memberships: from \$180.00 to \$200.00

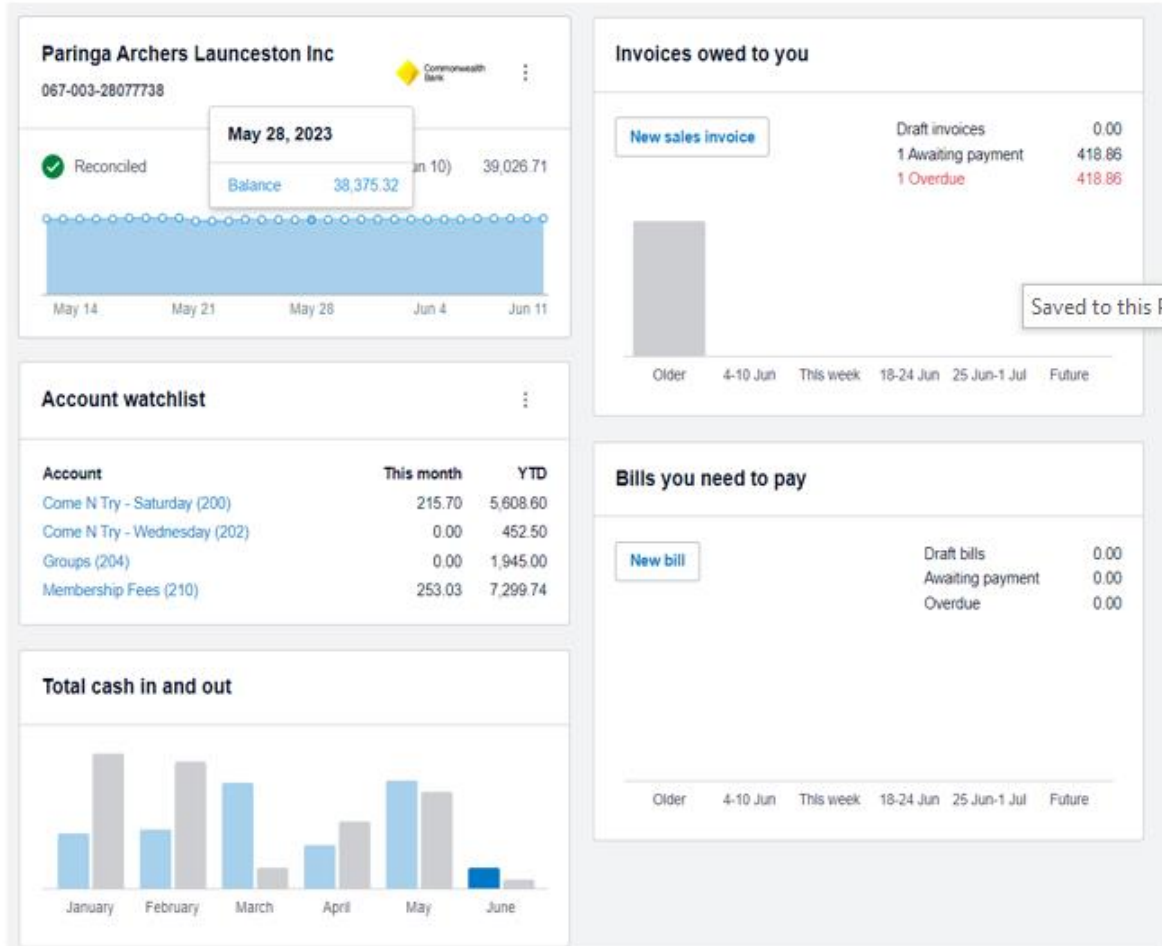
