The Archery Society of Tasmania has discussed the easing of restrictions with the Department of Sport and Recreation to confirm and clarify some of the finer points that effect Archery in Tasmania.

Here are the key changes:

- Sanitizer still to be provided.
- Toilets and club house may now be opened, BUT NEED TO BE CLEANED AFTER EACH DAY'S USE
- Maximum participants in outdoor sports are restricted to 500. We can, therefore, begin our 'Come and Try' and community groups. HOWEVER, any shared equipment must be sanitised between users.
- The 1.5 m social distancing is to be maintained WHERE PRACTICABLE. So, we can have 3 archers using one butt, as that's normal for our sport.
- Coaches are permitted to approach students to demonstrate or adjust form, but parents and spectators must adhere to the social distancing requirements.
- We still need to record who has been at the grounds, including parents and spectators

Please note that each Club can still determine what additional safety precautions they would like to adopt to maintain a common sense approach to keeping members and participants safe during this
