Competition News

July

VDA QRE Field

Held on the 2nd, Peter Holland was our only participant and managed a very competitive 253 with his longbow.

State/National Indoor Championships

We held this on the 9th and 10th and there was a reasonable turnout with 26 entries (six from Paringa), although still very much down on pre-pandemic levels. As is usual, Tasmania punched well above its weight in the national event and achieved three individual gold and five silver medals. Golds were: Barbara Joiner, VDA 60+ female recurve; Ian Bessel, Burnie 60+ male recurve and our own Peter MulHolland, 60+ male longbow. Silvers were: Toby Chalk, Hobart U14 male compound (His first major tournament!); Sarah Haywood, Hobart open female recurve (Not long returned from the world cup); Paringa's Terri Szabo, 50+ female Barebow recurve; Ian Bessel (again), 50+ male recurve and Stephen Potter, Hobart 70+ male compound (with two state records).

In the RGB team competition, all teams had to be mixed gender. Because we had no female compounders, Tassie could only enter a recurve team: and they came third – not too bad considering one member had to pull out at the last moment because he had to plant tulips! (he is a farmer ☺) In the other teams competition, we had some pleasing results:

50+, 60+ and 70+ compound – 1st and 3rd
50+, 60+ and 70+ recurve – 2nd (including Paul Fahey), 4th (including Jeff Garner) and 5th.
Open Barebow – 8th (including Peter MulHolland)
Open Compound – 4th
Open Recurve – 11th and 13th (again, missing one member)

In the state competition, Paringa members acquitted themselves well with three 1sts – Debbie Draeger 50+ female recurve, Terri Szabo, 50+ female barebow recurve and Peter MulHolland, 60+ male longbow. Emma Hutchinson came 2nd in open female recurve, Jeff Garner came 3rd in 60+ male recurve and Paul Fahey came 5th in 60+ male recurve.
