A great opportunity

We are looking at running courses for qualifications as Club Official and Level 1 Coach and need to get an idea of the people that may be interested in attending.

A **Club Official** is someone qualified to conduct club shoots or local tournaments under Archery Australia's guidelines. They ensure events run safely and by the rules, but they're not certified coaches — so they don't provide formal instruction.

The plan is to do the **online course** at <u>www.archeryeducation.com.au</u> at Paringa as a group but you can also do it yourself at any time.

A **Level 1 Coach** leads Come 'n' Try sessions and beginner programs at clubs. Teaches basic archery techniques, safety, and etiquette. Acts as the first point of contact for new archers — often shaping their long-term interest in the sport.

This will be a one-day course run at Paringa. You can attend any of these Coaching courses around Australia. Have a look at <u>Coaching Information for Coordinators</u>, <u>Presenters and Coaches</u> for more information.
